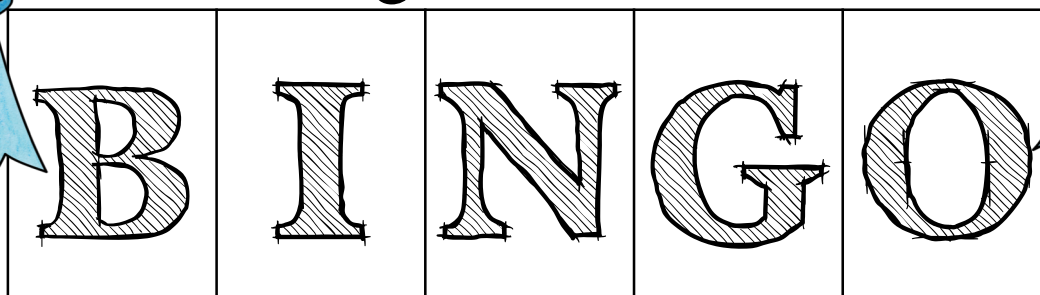

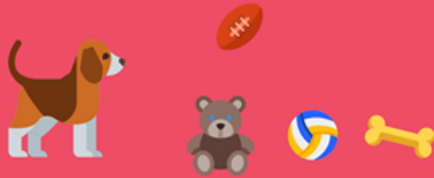
BINGO

Playing directions

1. Print the Call Sheets and the Bingo Cards
2. For added durability, place the bingo cards in sheet protectors
3. Cut out the squares on the call sheets and put them in a bowl or bin.
4. Give each student a bingo card. There are 10 different cards included in this bundle.
5. Have a volunteer pull a square out of the hat and tell the class what's on it. It may be simple or it may require a description. If the students don't understand the vocabulary being used, the caller can also show the image to the class
6. If the item that was called is on a student's Bingo card, they can mark it with a dry bean or another marker of your choice. (If you are using sheet protectors, students can use a dry erase marker to indicate that an item has been called.)
7. A student can call "BINGO" aloud if he or she has an entire row or column marked.
8. To make the game more challenging, students can also try to complete an X with their markers, do a square outline on the card, or even do "blackout" where every item has been called and marked.

Safety Tips for Kids & Dogs

Do not approach a dog if they are eating or playing with toys



Always ask an adult if you can touch a dog. Let the dog come to you and touch their chest



When dogs are passing. Keep a safe distance and try to remain still



If you want to feed treats, throw them. Do not let dogs eat from your hand



Keeping Safe Around Dogs

Never hug or kiss a dog



Do not go into a dog's crate or bed



If you want to play with a dog, ask them to come to you. If they don't come, give them space, and play quietly with your own toys















Remember, a waggy tail does not always mean a dog is happy
